Mike,

My fee for attending the meeting in Tucson will be \$10,000 plus expenses, paid in advance.

It will require 2 business days,

I charge \$675.00 / hour at 10 hours per day for a daily rate of \$6,750.00 and two day total of \$13,500.00. Kelley's rate is \$130.00 / hour at 10 hours per day for a daily rate if \$1,300.00 and two day total of \$2,600.00. This would bring the two day total to \$16,100.00 for professional services. However, I will charge Leader a flat fee of \$10,000 for professional services in this instance, representing a discount of \$6,100.00. Additionally, I will charge expenses.

The projected expense budget follows:

Airfare	\$783.00 (\$319 per traveler)
