The Municipal Ownership League of San Francisco passed resolutions yesterday calling upon the authorities immediately to take possession of the Geary-street railway and to operate it for the people. The league advised the immediate reconstruction of the road into a conduit electric system. The resolution is as follows:

Whereas, The Geary Street Railway Company has abandoned the operation of the railway on Geary street, owned by the city, and refuses to accommodate the people with street railway service, although it has been permitted to use this street without any franchise since 1903, and

Whereas, The receipts of the company during 1905 were \$162,616, of which \$90,000 was profit; and since the fire the receipts, according to the reports of that company to the Supervisors, have increased to \$294,702 a year, with an additional expense of less than \$10,000, thus yielding the company an additional profit of \$124,176, or a total profit during the year 1906, of \$212,176.

Therefore, Be it resolved by

The Municipal Ownership League of San Francisco that it is the duty of the city authorities immediately to take possession of this street railway, and operate it for the convenience and benefit of the people, and

Be it further resolved, That we demand that the sum of \$325,000, which has been available for that purpose in the City Treasury the last two years, be immediately used for the reconstruction of the roadway for the conduit electric system, which can be done without interfering with the operation of the cable cars.

Cannon Welcome Prince of Asturias—Brilliant Ceremonies Held at Palace.

Madrid, May 10.—A prince was born to Queen Victoria at 12:15 o'clock this afternoon. The baby was tenderly proclaimed successor to the Spanish crown and to the title of prince of Asturias. The Queen and the child which weighs 8 1/2 pounds are doing well. Queen Victoria, in spite of the custom to the contrary and opposition on the part of the members of the royal household, will nurse the child herself. OVERLAND ROADS TO INCREASE FREIGHT RATES

Sweeping Revision of Tariffs Is Planned by Transcontinental Lines.

NORTH COAST IS AFFECTED

Commodities Advanced Range From Soap to Champagne—Few Reductions.

Shippers are intensely interested in announcements that the Southern Pacific, Santa Fe and the other overland lines are revising their joint transcontinental freight tariff and that in the near future a large number of increased rates will be announced. The changes, it is said, will affect westbound shipments to this coast and will be effective from June 1st. The rates will be advanced on a wide range of commodities, including soap, champagne, and other goods. There will be few reductions.

CHAMPAGNE HAD HIT.
