prince, potentate, state, or sovereignty, and particularly to *Charles King of Roumania*,  
of which I am now a citizen-subject; I  
arrived at the port of *New York*, in the  
State Territory of *NY* on or about the *14* day  
of *March*, anno Domini *1892*; I am not an anarchist; I am not a  
polygamist nor a believer in the practice of polygamy; and it is my intention in good faith  
to become a citizen of the United States of America and to permanently reside therein:

To the Honorable the District Court of the United States for the Eastern District of Pennsylvania:  
The petition of *Leo Lieber*  
First. My place of residence is *804 No. 8<sup>th</sup> Street*.  
Second. My occupation is *Confectioner*.  
Third. I was born on the *8* day of *April*, anno Domini *1879*, at *Botoshani, Roumania*.  
Fourth. I emigrated to the United States from *Roumania via Hamburg*, on or about the *7* day of *March*, anno Domini *1892*, and arrived in the United States, as the port of *New York*, on the *14* day of *March*, anno Domini *1892*, on the vessel *Furst Bismarck*.  
Fifth. I declared my intention to become a citizen of the United States on the *1* day of *September*, anno Domini *1909*, at *Philadelphia, Pa.* in the *Circuit* Court of *U.S.E.D. of Pa.*  
Sixth. I am married. My wife's name is *Fannie*. She was born in *Phila, Roumania*, and now resides at *804 No. 8<sup>th</sup> Street*, PHILADELPHIA, Pennsylvania.  
I have *3* children, and the name, date and place of birth, and place of residence of each of said children is as follows:  
*John Walter*, born *October 20, 1903*, at *New York*  
*John*, born *June 10, 1908*, at *Phila, Pa.*  
*John*, born *June 20, 1911*, at *Phila, Pa.*

Seventh. I am not a disbeliever in or opposed to organized government or a member of or affiliated with any organization or body of persons teaching disbelief in or opposed to organized government. I am not a polygamist nor a believer in the practice of polygamy. I am attached to the principles of the Constitution of the United States, and it is my intention to become a citizen of the United States and to renounce absolutely and forever all allegiance and fidelity to any foreign prince, potentate, state, or sovereignty, and particularly to *Charles, King of Roumania*, of whom at this time I am a subject, and it is my intention to reside permanently in the United States.  
Eighth. I am able to speak the English language.  
Ninth. I have resided continuously in the United States of America for the term of five years at least, immediately preceding the date of this petition, to wit, since the *14* day of *March*, anno Domini *1892*, and in the State of Pennsylvania, continuously next preceding the date of this petition, since the *14* day of *August*, anno Domini *1906*, being a residence within this State of at least one year next preceding the date of this petition.  
Tenth. I have not heretofore made petition for citizenship to any court. (I made petition for citizenship to the \_\_\_\_\_ Court of \_\_\_\_\_ on the \_\_\_\_\_ day of \_\_\_\_\_, anno Domini \_\_\_\_\_, and the said petition was denied by the said Court for the following reasons and causes, to wit: \_\_\_\_\_ and the cause of such denial has since been cured or removed.)  
Attached hereto and made a part of this petition is my declaration of intention to become a citizen of the United States and the certificate from the Department of Commerce and Labor, together with my affidavits and the affidavits of the two verifying witnesses thereto, required by law. Wherefore your petitioner prays that he may be admitted a citizen of the United States of America.

each being severally, duly and respectively sworn, deposes and says that he is a citizen of the United States of America; that he has personally known the petitioner above mentioned, to have resided in the United States continuously immediately preceding the date of filing his petition, since the *20* day of *January*, anno Domini *1907*, and in the State in which the above-entitled petition is made continuously since the *25* day of *January*, anno Domini *1907*, and that he has personal knowledge that the said petitioner is a person of good moral character, attached to the principles of the Constitution of the United States, and that the petitioner is in every way qualified, in his opinion, to be admitted a citizen of the United States.

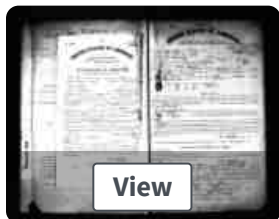
