He served as the Chief Executive Officer and the Chairman of the Board at Internet Security Systems Inc. since November 1996, and the President and a Member of the Board of Directors since August 1995. Mr. Noonan served as the Vice President of Sales and Marketing with TSI International, Inc. from October 1994 to August 1995. Earlier, he founded two technology companies Actuation Electronics and Leapfrog Technologies. He held senior positions at Dun and Bradstreet Software, where he was vice president, Worldwide Marketing. He serves as a Director of Phantom Cyber Corp. He has been the Chairman of the Board at Oversight Systems, Inc. since April 2009. He serves as Chairman of the Board at NIAC Evaluation and Enhancement of Information Sharing and Analysis Working Group. He served as the Chairman of the Board at Endgame, Inc. and serves as its Director. He serves as Observer of BrightPoint Security, Inc. Mr. Noonan has been an Independent Director at Manhattan Associates, Inc. since January 1999. He serves as a Director of Vorstack Corporation. He serves as a Trustee of Georgia Research Alliance, Inc. He serves as a Member of Advisory Board of Air2Web, Inc. He serves as a Director of KnowledgeStorm, Inc. He serves as a Member of Advisory Board at Noro-Moseley Partners, Arcapita Ventures I, L.P. and Arcapita Bank, Venture Capital Arm. Mr. Noonan serves as a Member of Board of Advisors at CodeGuard Inc. He has been a Director of Ionic Securities Ltd. since April 19, 2013 and Ionic Security, Inc. since April 19, 2013. He serves on the boards of Metro Atlanta Chamber of Commerce, Woodruff Arts Center, Georgia Tech Foundation, Young President's Organization and The Georgia Institute of Technology. Mr. Noonan is also is a Member of the Board of Technology Executive Roundtable, Georgia Tech College of Computing Board Chair, and Carter Center board of counselors. He served as a Director of Purewire, Inc. since August 2008. He served as a Director at Neovest Holdings, Inc. and BrightPoint Security, Inc. He served as a Member of Advisory Board at Rohati Systems, Inc. and nuBridges, Inc. He was also elected to the National Board of Directors for the American Electronics Association. In 2002, President Bush appointed him to serve on the National Infrastructure Advisory Council (NIAC). He is also an active philanthropist through the work of the Thomas E. Noonan Family foundation which supports education, environmental and healthcare causes locally and nationally. In 1999, Ernst and Young recognized him as "Entrepreneur of the Year." He was recognized with the "Lifetime Achievement Award" at the RSA Security conference. He has been recognized by industry leading publications and associations including Forbes, Business Week and Fortune and was named Ernst and Young's 1999 Entrepreneur of the Year. He is a frequent speaker at leading industry events and has delivered keynote addresses at such venues as the G8 Summits in Kyoto, Japan and Sea Island, Georgia, Interop Las Vegas, the RSA Conference, SUMAQ Summit, CSIA Town Hall, Japan External Trade Organization, Atlanta Rotary Club, and Forbes CEO events in the United States, Singapore and Mexico. Most recently, he was named a "Most Admired CEO" in Atlanta in 2015 by the Atlanta Business Chronicle. Mr. Noonan holds Mechanical Engineering degree from the

Georgia Institute of Technology and a Business degree from Harvard University.
