Huma,

Not sure as to Penny's ability to reply in advance of your call, but CGI has maintained a track/working group dedicated to the issue of girls and women over the course of this year. Penny has conducted dozens of calls and in-person meetings with the group since March. That said, we don't want to treat the issue of girls and women as a siloed/stand-alone topic at the Annual Meeting in September, but rather integrate it across multiple sessions and issues at the meeting. Having dedicated a day to the topic of girls and women at last year's meeting, we saw a drop-off in attendance at those sessions and want to incorporate the issue throughout the meeting for greater promotion. Melanne was at CGI's planning retreat in February when/where this approach was discussed and endorsed by our advisors so I'm surprised if there is any confusion on this point.

Would LOVE to have Penny join. I do want us to be seamless in that regard. do think we should coordinate beforehand because I am talking to her as a follow up to an email she sent to hrc about a different, new approach. I'm sending the text below.

Dear Secretary Clinton,

We have attended the Clinton Global Initiative now for a few years and feel it is an important gathering of some of the finest and most important people thinking about International Aid. We do, however, feel that women's issues have not gotten the attention or the placement that they deserve. We are hoping you might consider helping us "rock the boat" a little bit this year.

I know that the staff at CGI is hoping to do a plenary with you this year on Design and Urbanization and while this may be worthwhile, we are wondering if you would consider joining with us to make a counter proposal for a different plenary that would be much more meaningful.

There is a great deal of energy at CGI about women, but generally this energy is confined to issue areas that are, for want of a better phrase, "safe." What is more, we have found there to be a distinct lack of support for any and all discussion of Women's Rights specifically. It would be amazing if we could bring a plenary to this year's conference with you and Leymah and some other high profile people (Zainab Salbi I am sure would be glad to do it, as would Ashley Judd and/or Ben Affleck, either of whom would be great) to talk about why none of this talk will get us anywhere unless we talk about Women's Rights.

This is just a loose idea, still in formation, but is this something you might be willing to support us in trying?

Dear Mr. President,

I'm recently returned from the 6th Summit of the Americas in Cartagena—an experience that brought back powerful memories of your leadership in Miami in 1994. You won't be surprised to hear me affirm that Secretary Clinton was superb, as always, in her dealings with her Latin and Caribbean counterparts. It is rewarding to see the progress the Americas have made, on behalf of democracy, peace, and prosperity.

But the purpose of my outreach today concerns a different part of the world: Russia. As you know, Russia will be acceding to the World Trade Organization this summer, which will enable all other WTO signatories to take advantage of lowered tariffs to Russia's market.

The United States, however, still has the 1974 Jackson-Vanik legislation in force, which will prevent U.S. businesses and manufacturers in key export sectors including IT, farm equipment, and energy, from benefiting. As my McLarty Associates colleague Ambassador Rick Burt has observed, it's a self-inflicted wound.

Brent Scowcroft has approached President George H.W. Bush about the possibility of a joint Bush-Clinton op-ed that would make the case for removing this Cold War-era legislation from the books. President Bush is receptive, but wants to be sure that you are too. It seems to me, given your strong record of support for trade liberalization, the fact the WTO came into being under your presidency, and the way you helped to usher in a new era of U.S.-Russian relations, that this would be a fitting and meaningful topic for you to address. And certainly, your joint statement on the matter would carry tremendous weight and influence on both sides of the aisle.

Please don't hesitate to let me know if you need any additional information or background material as you consider this request.

Mr. President, thank you for your consideration of this matter. I think it is a very timely and important one or I would not have reached out to you.

1. MISSION IS REQUESTED TO DELIVER THE FOLLOWING MESSAGE FROM SECRETARY CLINTON TO PRESIDENT KAGAME UNDER THE COVER OF A DIPLOMATIC NOTE. IT IS OUR HOPE THAT SPECIAL ADVISOR FOR THE GREAT LAKES AND THE DRC AMBASSADOR BARRIE WALKLEY WILL PRESENT THIS LETTER TO PRESIDENT KAGAME DURING EITHER HIS JUNE 28-JULY 1 OR HIS JULY 3-5 VISIT TO RWANDA. THERE WILL BE NO ORIGINAL SIGNED LETTER TO FOLLOW.

2. BEGIN TEXT:

Dear Mr. President:

I would like to take this opportunity to renew our strong bilateral relationship and cooperation on regional and international affairs. I am deeply concerned, however, about the deteriorating security situation in the Democratic Republic of the Congo (DRC). The United States appreciates that Rwanda has long-standing and legitimate concerns about instability in eastern DRC. We have encouraged the DRC government and the UN peacekeeping operation, even as they counter the

M23 mutineers, to remain focused on demobilizing the Democratic Forces for the Liberation of Rwanda militia and vigilant toward the threat of violence against all civilians, including Congolese Rwandophone or Kinyarwanda-speaking communities. In turn, we encourage Rwanda to address these common concerns in partnership with the DRC as the DRC government asserts effective sovereignty over its territory. Stabilization in eastern DRC is in the best interests of Rwanda, the DRC, and the broader international community.

I am gravely troubled by the body of evidence regarding Rwandan support for the M23 mutineers. Rwanda has earned a reputation as an effective advocate and partner for international peace and security in many situations around the world. To maintain Rwanda's reputation and productive relationship with the international diplomatic and business community, I urge you to demonstrate clearly that Rwanda is working together with the Congolese government to support stability and contain and defeat the ongoing militia in the DRC that has tragically led to still more displacement and refugee flows to Rwanda and Uganda. I encourage you to do everything possible to ensure no one in your government is doing anything to aid armed groups in eastern DRC.

Your vision for Rwanda's future as a developed and peaceful country that attracts foreign investment and enjoys a high standard of living is a compelling one that the United States wholeheartedly supports. We believe that vision is only achievable and sustainable, however, in the context of mutual respect and cooperation between the DRC and Rwanda. I have sent Ambassador Barrie Walkley to Kigali to continue our dialogue about the crisis in eastern DRC and to hear your perspective on the best way to find a resolution to both the immediate crisis and the complex issues that underlie it.

The United States greatly values its strong relationship with Rwanda and looks forward to continued cooperation, including on regional security.

Background on Current Rwanda/DRC Tensions

Relations between the Democratic Republic of the Congo (DRC) and Rwanda have been tense since documented allegations emerged in May that Rwanda was supporting a mutiny among Congolese soldiers.

Facing rumors that his arrest was imminent, Bosco Ntaganda, a Congolese general wanted for war crimes by the International Criminal Court, began in March 2012 to build support for a mutiny among his fellow Congolese ex-rebels of Rwandan descent (so-called "Rwandophones"). Ntaganda previously belonged to an abusive armed group called the CNDP (National Congress for the Defense of the People) that enjoyed Rwanda's backing as a proxy force until its nominal integration into the Congolese army through an agreement signed on March 23, 2009.

In the years following their 2009 integration, ex-CNDP forces maintained a parallel chain of command under Ntaganda's leadership. This provided them with autonomy from the central government and allowed them to pursue outsized political and economic influence in the DRC's Kivu provinces, which border Rwanda. As the guarantors of this unwritten arrangement, Rwandan officials benefitted economically through the ex-CNDP's control of the illicit minerals trade, politically by sustaining their influence over Congolese Rwandophones, and militarily by reducing the DRC's ability to control territory neighboring Rwanda.

While the DRC government had tolerated Ntaganda's growing power as the price of peace and of good relations with Rwanda, his March 2012 mutiny led the DRC government, with encouragement from the international community, to take action to against him. Between March and late April, Rwanda appeared to support the DRC's efforts to defeat and arrest Ntaganda. As the DRC's efforts began to extend beyond capturing Ntaganda and to include dismantling the broader parallel chains of command, Rwanda began instead to provide covert support to Ntaganda -- who took a lower-profile role in favor of less-notorious figures. The mutiny officially constituted itself as the "M23" movement, referencing the March 23, 2009 integration accord that they claimed the DRC failed to honor.

Ntaganda and M23's other senior officers are alleged to have perpetrated extensive human rights abuses in the last few years, including most recently the forced recruitment of men and children. While M23 and Congolese army forces had fought to a standstill in a relatively small area near the DRC-Rwanda-Uganda border, M23 forces recently broke out of their salient and captured several key Congolese towns between July 6 and 8 in a show of strength. UN peacekeepers

have been aggressively deployed to protect civilians from the rebels, but the weakness and disorganization of Congolese forces allowed the M23 to take significant population centers. The M23 relinquished some of these towns, but their actions have sharply raised ethnic tensions. The M23 has generally avoided direct contact with UN peacekeepers, but an Indian soldier was killed during on July 5 when the rebels clashed with Congolese forces.

While Rwanda has publicly and privately denied it supports the mutiny, the UN Group of Experts (GOE) on the DRC has credibly documented the provision of support – including weapons, recruits, transport, and political advice – to the M23 rebels by senior Rwandan military officials. These officials include the Rwandan minister of defense, his deputy, and Rwanda's top general. The GOE's findings were publicly released on June 29, prompting further denials from Rwanda and sharp objections from the DRC. UN officials strongly suspect that Rwandan support helped account for the M23's sudden success in its July 6-8 offensive.

Rwanda's support in general appears aimed at strengthening the rebels' hand in negotiating their reintegration into the army on terms of significant autonomy similar to what prevailed following the 2009 accords. Such support would violate the UN arms embargo and several regional treaties and has negative implications for our ability to provide at least some forms of security assistance to Rwanda.

The Department of State issued a statement on June 30 expressing our deep concern about the findings and noting that we "have asked Rwanda to halt and prevent the provision of such support from its territory." Secretary Clinton wrote a letter to President Kagame on July 2 making a similar request and expressing deep concerns; President Kagame, in a July 9 reply and a July 11 conversation with Under Secretary Wendy Sherman again denied Rwandan involvement. Rwandan officials have made counter-allegations that the DRC government is attacking Congolese Rwandophones and collaborating with the DRC-based remnants of the genocidal Rwandan militias, but we have seen no corroboration of this.

Congolese and Rwandan officials have met repeatedly at senior levels in the several months since the mutiny began. The foreign ministers met in Kinshasa on June 18-19, producing a joint communiqué that renewed past commitments for the mutual respect of sovereignty and non-support to destabilizing forces. Most recently, DRC, Rwanda, and representatives from nine other countries represented in the International Conference on the Great Lakes Region (ICGLR) met in Addis Ababa on July 11-12 to discuss possible arrangements for third-party monitoring of the DRC-Rwanda border and joint operations against M23 and other armed groups.

Preliminary plans were submitted at the time to AAN, to MTPTC (AAN's ministry-in-charge) and to PM. No reaction, one way or the other, from anybody.

The matter may have come to the attention of the press as a result of its mention at the reception thrown by AA last week for the 40th anniversary of its operations in Haiti.

UW student to make case for Haiti project at Clinton seminar

Several Washington students will be in the nation's capitol this week for a conference that encourages college students to find ways to solve the world's problems.

For more than two years now, 22-year old Analesse Isherwood has been making regular visits to Haiti — bringing school supplies to students, teaching adults about cholera and searching for a way to create patient medical records that could be used by intermittent traveling clinics.

This week, though, she is going in a different direction: to Washington, D.C., where she is one of three college students from this state taking part in the Clinton Global Initiative University. The three-day seminar is designed to help college students think about how they might solve the world's most complex problems.

It's the fifth year of the meeting, which mirrors the Clinton Global Initiative, an international meeting held each September in New York City and founded by former President Clinton. The September meeting brings world leaders together to work on the world's problems.

In a news conference conducted by phone this week, Clinton described how the student meeting is designed to be similar to the September meeting. More than 1,000 students will attend from all 50 states and 75 countries and hear from speakers such as former Secretary of State Madeleine Albright, Twitter co-founder Biz Stone and The Daily Show's Jon Stewart.

They'll also get a chance to network, organize and work together on projects of their own choosing. "Students are more connected online than ever before," Clinton said. "It's obvious they need to be organized on the ground."

A native of Moses Lake, Isherwood — who is a first-year medical student in the University of Washington's Spokane program — is working on her medical-records idea to help clinic workers in Haiti keep better track of patients' health history. She started the week in New York City, meeting with nonprofit-health organizations that work in Haiti, and plans to network with other students and health-care workers at the Clinton event.

She first visited Haiti with a nonprofit group in December 2009, when she was a Western Washington University undergraduate and curious to learn more about the living conditions of people in developing nations.

Two weeks after she left Haiti, in January 2010, the country was devastated by a catastrophic earthquake that killed some of the people she had met on her trip.

Since then, she has returned five more times as a volunteer — raising money with help from her church, her hometown Rotary Club, a local physician, friends and family. Each trip costs about \$1,500; she used money from her own savings for the last trip, in December.

"If you truly believe in what you're doing, you make it happen and are willing to sacrifice for it," she said.

She's gotten thousands of dollars in donations from Moses Lake residents — in particular, from middle-school students whose classrooms she has visited to tell about her trips to Haiti.

Getting students to care about poor children in a country more than 3,000 miles away was a challenge, she said. She brought photos of her trips and pictures of specific students in need. In response, the students have given her money to buy school supplies, toys and other items.

The Clinton conference is also focused on finding ways to get young people engaged in long-term, global problems. It comes just weeks after a YouTube video about the crimes of African warlord Joseph Kony went viral on social media — an example of how social media can be used to galvanize political activism, especially among young people.

Clinton was enthusiastic about the wave of interest in the Ugandan human-rights issues that Kony2012 unleashed, despite questions raised about whether all of the information was accurate.

"I think it was a real plus that it was made, that it came out," said Clinton, who noted that the video was viewed by millions of people and sparked discussions about human-rights abuses in Uganda.

The Kony video "also opens up, to young people who saw it, the chance to figure out what they could do to help people," Clinton said.

The video told some of the story through the eyes of a young Ugandan boy whose brother was killed by Kony soldiers. In one sense, "it's very similar to what I do," Isherwood said. "I play on the kids' hearts, yes. But all for a good reason."

"Despite their young age, they're capable of making a difference," Isherwood said of the middle-school students she has met with. "I'm really setting them up for a long-term perspective change. If you can start it at a young age, you can make a true difference in changing someone's life."

Jake, Huma, and Declan: As you know, we have been working with Queen's University on hosting the economic event. Yes, we have gone pretty far so it would be difficult to change the venue completely. (The Queen's Vice Chancellor Peter Gregson offered us the moon yesterday -- including having a speech for 700-1,000 and the roundtable event and use of the Great Hall as a reception area before the speech. We will walk him back to a smaller event Monday morning.)

And on substance -- I think Queen's highlights education, research and new technologies, and economic commercialization of research results. The executive director of the NI Tourism Board met with us yesterday along with Invest NI folks to press for the Titanic Signature Project to be a center piece of the economic event in some way. I asked them what role U.S. investors or companies were playing in the Titanic Signature Project and there wasn't a clear answer. (The Invest NI folks actually joked that link was that the Titanic was on its way to America.) I also asked about

the visual message of the event -- to be honest it is actually a big dirt construction site. (Our original suggestion on Titanic Quarter was the Science Park venue.) I actually think the dig has begun so it truly is a big hole.

But all that said the drive times are short in Belfast and it would be possible to go to the Quarter on the way out of town or in for a quick event if that is desired. I would suggest we wait and see what happens with the schedule overall before making a decision.

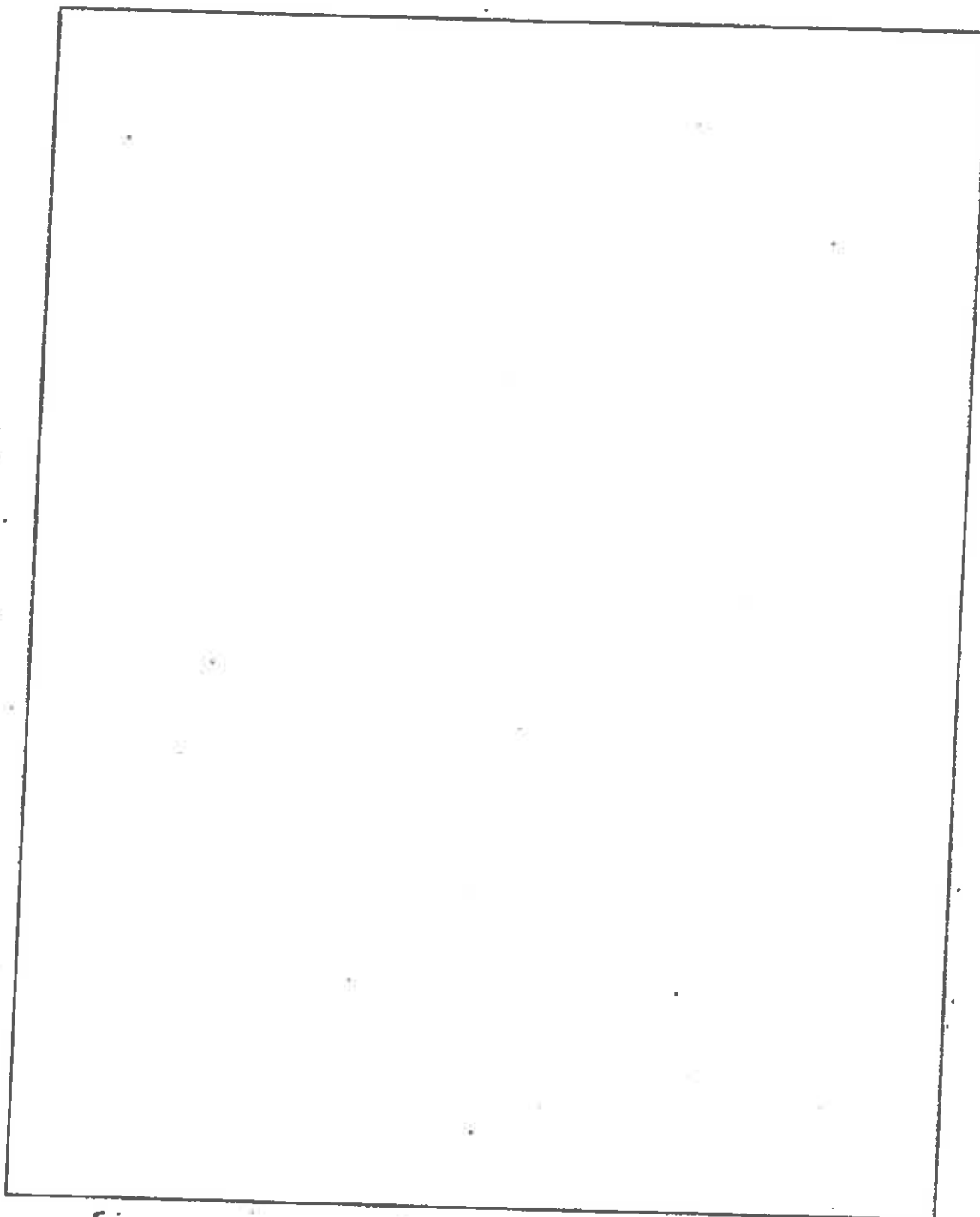

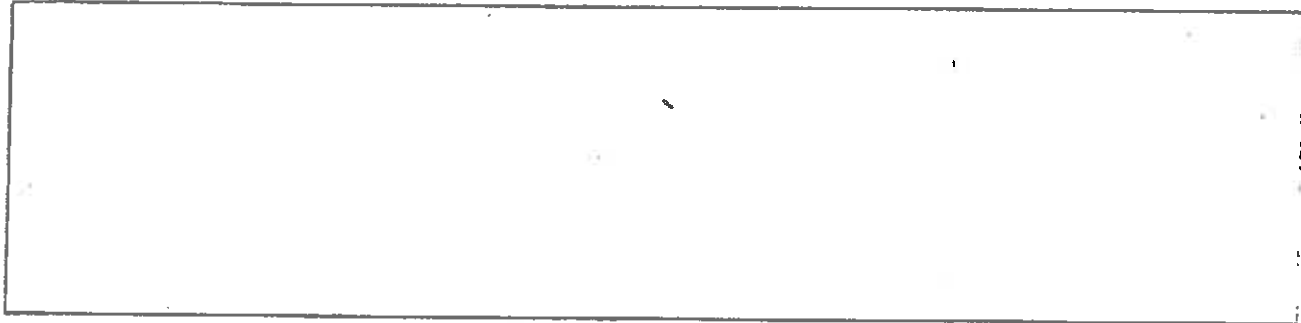
