

Background

Mr. Antle serves as the Chief Executive Officer and President of Salient Federal Solutions, Inc. Mr. Antle serves as the Chief Executive Officer at Salient Solutions LLC. He serves as the Chief Executive Officer of Salient CRGT and served as its President until September 15, 2015. Mr. Antle served as President of SI International from 2005 to 2008 and its Chief Executive Officer from September 24, 2005 to 2008. Mr. Antle has overall responsibility for marketing and sales, revenue management, client relations, and directing SI International's operating units. From June 1999 to February 2001, Mr. Antle served as SI International's Executive Vice President. Mr. Antle served as a Director of Engineering with Lockheed Martin Corporation from 1996 to 1999 and from 1999 to 2001. He has shared oversight of the acquisition and integration of six companies. Within three years of establishing the new engineering division, Mr. Antle built Lockheed Martin to over 1,700 engineers, supporting twenty-one sites and seventy programs. He has been with SI International since 1999 and has more than 26 years of management experience in industry. He served as President of Serco Services, Inc. (also known as SI) since 2001 and served as its Chief Operating Officer from 2001 to September 2005. He joined SI Founders in 1999 to run the first acquisition and spearhead acquisitions going forward. He was Naval Officer, 8 years Active force, 22 years Reserves. Prior to joining SI International, Mr. Antle was named the first director of Washington Technical Operations for Lockheed Martin in 1996. Mr. Antle began his corporate career at General Electric in 1985, as a senior systems engineer. After successfully spearheading a variety of systems engineering assignments, he was selected in 1990 to form a Quality Engineering department of 150 professionals, supporting over \$400 million in development contracts. In 1992, he was promoted to senior program manager for a 110-person, multi-site program with overseas operations. Before joining General Electric, Mr. Antle served in the U.S. Navy for eight years as a surface warfare officer and was deputy department head for Systems Engineering at one of the Navy's software development facilities for tactical embedded systems. He serves as Chairman of Northern Virginia Technology Council. He serves as Director of MATCOM International Corporation. He has been Director of Serco Services, Inc. since September 24, 2005. Following his release from active military service, Mr. Antle served in the Naval Reserve, holding several reserve commands, including his most recent command of a Naval Surface Warfare Center Dahlgren Division unit. He retired from the Naval Reserve with the rank of captain. Mr. Antle is active in numerous community and business organizations as a board member of the Red Hat Government Advisory Board; On Point advisory board; the National Defense Industrial Association (NDIA) board; board of directors of Boys and Girls Club of Greater Washington; and past chairman of the board for the Software & Systems Consortium. Mr. Antle earned a master's degree in engineering from Penn State University, an M.B.A. from the National University in San Diego, Calif., and a Bachelor of Science in business administration from the University of Maryland.
