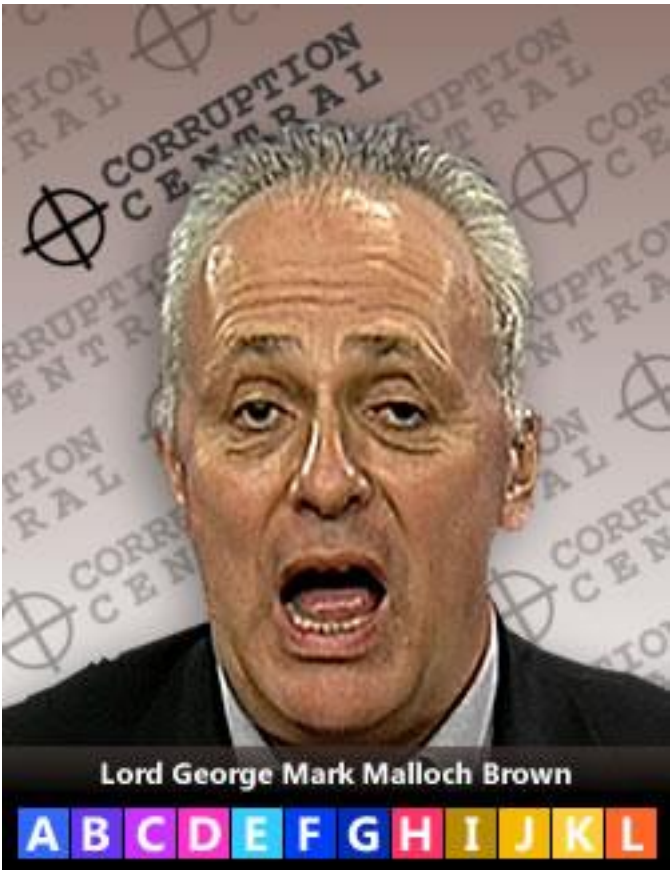

Sir Kenneth Raymond **Pelly** was born on 9 November 1893.¹ He was the son of [Herbert Cecil Pelly](#) and [Mary Richenda Carter](#).² He married [Elsbeth Norna Grant](#), daughter of [Robert Campbell Grant](#), on 15 October 1919.¹ He died on 30 September 1973 at age 79.¹

He was educated at [Charterhouse School, Godalming, Surrey, England](#).¹ He gained the rank of Captain in the Royal Army Service Corps.¹ He fought in the First World War.¹ He was awarded the Military Cross (M.C.).¹ He was President of the Chamber of Shipping between 1956 and 1957.¹ He was chairman of Lloyd's Register of Shipping between 1957 and 1963.¹ He was appointed Knight in 1961.¹
