Hi all,

I have a need to search my dataset before displaying the rows on a report. I have to check to see if 2 rows have offestting values, and if they do, I need to exclude them from the report. I was thinking that I can set a column to "N" or something like that, for the rows I want to hide, then filter them out

I am using a scripted data set, and my basic idea was to loop through all of the rows retrieved in the 'beforeClose' event, secrebing for the ones I do not want to show on the report.

Does anyone know if this is possible, or will work? Can I loop through the dataset as kind of a "pre-process" to clean up the data?

Any other ideas would be greaty appreciated.
