

Jane's International Defence Review (*IDR*) is a monthly <u>magazine</u> reporting on <u>military</u> news and technology.

History and profile

International Defense Review was established in 1968. [1] It was published by Interavia SA (Geneva, Switzerland) until it as acquired by Jane's Publishing Group in 1987. [2] According to one entry in WorldCat, the name of the magazine was International Defense Review, [1] but another WorldCat entry states that the name was International Defence Review from 1968 until 1995. [3] Yet another WorldCat entry states that the title is IHS Jane's International Defence Review after 2012. [4]

The *IDR* is one of a number of military-related publications named after <u>Fred T. Jane</u>, an Englishman who first published <u>Jane's All the World's Fighting Ships</u> in 1898. It is a unit of <u>Jane's Information</u> Group, which was acquired by IHS Inc. in 2007. [5]

The magazine provides in-depth coverage and analysis of air, land and sea platforms and systems, and regularly features articles on equipment upgrade programmes, strategic and security issues, military doctrine, electronics and computing, operations and training and foreign affairs. It is widely considered to be a reputable source of public domain information regarding defence systems and military and industry news.

Jane's Defence Weekly was established in 1984 replacing the now-defunct Jane's Defence Review. [3] The latter was started in 1978 and was published on a monthly basis. [6]

Samuel Loring Morison

In 1984, only months after the magazine was established, *Jane's Defence Weekly* gained worldwide attention after printing several images from an American spy satellite of the Nikolaiev 444 shipyard in the Black Sea, showing a Kiev-class aircraft carrier under construction. The images were leaked by Samuel Loring Morison, an American intelligence professional, leading to the only conviction ever passed against a US government official for giving classified information to the press. [7][8]
