Journal of Race Development

The **Journal of Race Development** was the first American academic journal of international relations. It was founded in 1910 by G. Stanley Hall^[1] along with George Hubbard Blakeslee, both of Clark University. Despite a name which now suggests a journal devoted to eugenics, the journal, in fact, dealt with a variety of topics connected with politics, foreign affairs and international relations. It was renamed the *Journal of International Relations* [2] which in turn was merged with <u>Foreign</u> Affairs in 1922.


